What work is the Office for the PCC undertaking to monitor the implementation and uptake of the Community Remedy?</p> <p>Northumbria Police and the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Northumbria are collaborating on expanding the scope of the use of 'Out of Court Disposals'. A principal part of this is the Community Remedy. There is particular attention being paid to the use of Community Resolution and Conditional Cautions. We are actively researching opportunities to expand the options available to victims of crime in this area. This work has only just commenced (early October) and is planned to develop over the next 12 months.</p> <p>Q2.
