Storage Licence with Durham Police

Report of the Head of Strategic Asset Management

Summary

Northumbria Police has a requirement to retain crime exhibits and archives. Many of these are currently housed in buildings which are scheduled for disposal. Durham Police have a purpose built storage archive at Peterlee which has sufficient capacity to house the Northumbria archives in the closing buildings. It is proposed that a licence is taken with Durham Police for use of their spare capacity.

Recommendations / Findings

It is recommended that the Commissioner agrees to a licence and Heads of Terms for the use of the Durham archive facility at Peterlee.
